Vineyard Profile

100% Pinot Noir, Londer Estate Vineyard, Anderson Valley

Located twelve miles from the Pacific Ocean, the Londer Vineyard is nestled just northwest of the Mendocino County village of Philo. The 15-acre vineyard is planted on south-facing slopes, in an effort to capture both morning and evening sunlight, important in a cool and often fog-laden microclimate. Due to the nearby Navarro River, the soils are alluvial and sandy on top of clay-based loam, providing an ideal and well-draining environment for Pinot Noir.

Winemaker Notes

Aromas of ripe Rainier cherries with undertones of rose petals, citrus, leather and damp forest floor. Flavors focus on bright, high-toned cherry with underpinnings of orange zest and rose petals framed by velvety ripe tannins and subtle, well-integrated oak spice. Lingering cleansing finish with bright cherry interwoven with notes of rose petals.
