The Sonoma Coast is a world-renowned growing region known worldwide for its Chardonnay and Pinot Noir and microclimates that contribute to slow grape maturation and optimum ripeness. The well respected and highly sought after Sangiacomo Vineyard, on Roberts Road, is an elegant addition to the Calstar Cellars portfolio.

The Roberts Road Vineyard, located at the northern end of the Petaluma Gap with cobbled alluvial soil and bench deposits, has proven itself to be the ideal location influenced by morning fog, warm days and strong afternoon winds leaving the grapes plenty of hang time and development of distinct flavors.

This premier vintage from the Sangiacomo family's Roberts Road Vineyard enjoys the artful combination of California ripeness and European style.

Winemaker Notes

Pale straw in color with smoky aromas of Asian pear and hazelnut leading to ripe apple on the palate. Each taste is framed with a rich mouthfeel and balanced acidity framed with a subtle oak finish. A well-balanced structure reinforces a clean finish with a hint of citrus.
