The premier vintage of Calstar Cellars Sauvignon Blanc introduces a small lot of grapes sourced from the Hopkins Ranch vineyard in the Russian River Valley. With a long, cool growing season, the cool climate of the Russian River Valley keeps wines crisp while allowing the natural character of the climate to shine through. The picturesque Hopkins Ranch leads down-slope towards the Russian River.

The grapes offer a combination of a sophisticated Sancerre of the Loire Valley and the grassier New Zealand selections. This is a California wine for a Sauvignon Blanc enthusiast.

Winemaker Notes

Pale straw color with aromas of wet stone, grass and citrus. Crisp minerality compliments the medium-bodied, full-flavored profile leading to a clean, lengthy finish. This Sauvignon Blanc is the perfect compliment for warm weather fare.
