Roberts Road Vineyard, Sonoma Coast

The Sonoma Coast is a world-renowned growing region known worldwide for its cool-climate Pinot Noir and microclimates that contribute to slow grape maturation and optimum ripeness. The well respected and highly sought after Sangiacomo Vineyard Pinot Noir on Roberts Road is an elegant addition to the Calstar Cellars portfolio.

The Roberts Road Vineyard, located at the northern end of the Petaluma Gap with cobbled alluvial soil and bench deposits, has proven itself to be the ideal location influenced by morning fog, warm days and strong afternoon winds leaving the grapes plenty of hang time and development of distinct flavors.

This premier vintage from the Sangiacomo family's Roberts Road Vineyard enjoys the artful combination of California ripeness and Burgundian style.

Winemaker Notes

Dark ruby violet color carried by bright aromatics of ripe strawberry and cranberry with undertones of black tea, fresh mushrooms and cedar. Juicy acidity leads the palate with black plum, strawberry and bing cherry. Supporting flavors of vanilla, baking spices and orange peel linger through the finish.
