Vineyard Profile

100% Chardonnay, Indinoli Vineyard, Sonoma Coast

Indinoli Vineyard is located on Vine Hill School Road in the Santa Rosa Laguna region, known for its cooler temperatures, foggy mornings and sandy soils. It is planted to a mix of Old Wente, Robert Young, and #4, #8 and #809 Clones of Chardonnay. This clonal variation takes advantage of the varied aspects of the vineyard and adds great complexity to the wines from this site.

Winemaker Notes

The balance and length of the vintage is perfectly captured in this bottling. Immediately ripe and bright on the nose, notes of pear, green apple and wet rock are supported by fresh cut hay and an intriguing burst of cucumber. Great richness follows on the palette – toasted graham cracker and baked pear anchor lively flavors of zesty Meyer lemon and sweet grapefruit. The cool growing site shines in the finish – lingering minerality and citrus round out the mouth and give balance to the full, fruit-forward body from a gorgeous growing season and ideal coastal site.
